INCENTIVE AWARD

Bringing Shelter and Communities Together

Working as a team with their human companions, dogs of all shapes and sizes have passed the AKC Canine Good Citizen® test and are now recognized as valued members of their communities.

Animal Farm Foundation provides an Incentive Award designed to encourage dog and owner teams in a community to earn their AKC Canine Good Citizen® certification as a way to support their local shelters and rescues.

While all dogs are welcome to participate, Animal Farm Foundation will award \$150 to qualified* participating organizations for each “pit bull” dog, who along with his owner, successfully completes the CGC program. The Incentive Award is available only for owned dogs in the community, and encourages cultivation of the human-canine bond between dog and handler. Dogs do not have to be adopted through the participating organization, which presents a great opportunity for commitment from new and yet-unreached members of the community.

*Qualifying programs must be run through a 501(c)(3) not-for-profit organization.
