To qualify, the Perfect Match nominees must have been together for at least three months. The dog must be a “pit bull” dog or a “pit bull” dog mix.

The owner should be active in the community, and be a positive role model for responsible pet ownership.

*Qualifying programs must be run through a 501(c)(3) not-for-profit organization.
