

COMMUNITY SPAY/NEUTER SUPPORT PROGRAM

Animal welfare organizations best serve their communities when they develop strong partnerships within the community, utilizing each organization's strengths to deliver every dog owner the opportunity for low-cost and accessible spay/neuter services.

Most dog owners want to provide good care for their pets but some owners need assistance. Safe and humane communities provide accessible and affordable services so everyone has the opportunity to be a responsible pet owner.

To encourage the development of a sustainable and accessible program, Animal Farm Foundation will reimburse qualifying* spay/neuter programs up to \$50 per spay/neuter surgery for owned "pit bull" dogs in their community.

*Qualifying programs must be run through a 501(c)(3) not-for-profit organization.
